- Assisting passengers with ski hire and ski lessons
- Hosting nightlife in resort, (for example meals, bar and club nights etc)
- Carrying out room rounds throughout the week, delivering vital information to passengers and answering any questions or issues they may have
- Assisting with the departure process and helping passengers have a smooth check out and all the information they require
- Ad hoc resort requirements, such as assisting with medical issues, passenger requests and resort runner duties
- Represent NUCO in resort
- Hosting and staffing our events in resort

When and Where you'll work

We will allocate our rep team based on their performance, experience, and the requirements of the group/ week. Our reps can normally expect to work between 2 and 5 weeks through the season. However, this will be subject to change based sales for the year and other factors.
